This has been a very productive year for our community. Some of the highlights include our Children's Christmas Party, Fall Barbecue (thanks Wade Britt!), Spring and Fall Yard Sales, and the Children's Easter Party. Ellen Virtue, SPHA Social Committee Chairperson, has done an excellent job coordinating each of these events.

Many of you have also noticed that we accomplished several important upgrades to our community's infrastructure. One upgrade involves the much needed facelift that our playground received with the addition of a commercial grade swing set. A great deal of work was involved in completing this project. We had to remove several large trees, level the ground, cut out many exposed roots, build a completely new playground border, and fill the "new" playground with several truckloads of mulch. The adjacent pavilion was also repainted and repaired. Mitch Birzer led this project and we are hoping it will be a great benefit for the many young Silverwood families in our community.

Another important 2019 accomplishment was the clubhouse drainage project. While completion of the landscaping is still a work in progress, the drainage issues were resolved. The next phase of this project will include painting the new retaining walls, installation of new landscaping, erection of new fencing, and creation of a new irrigation system. Jim Browning's excellent project management efforts enabled all work to be completed under budget. As Chairperson for the Roads and Drainage Committee, Jim has also served as project manager for the many drainage projects accomplished this year. While there is still much work to be done, we are incrementally addressing the most pressing drainage issues as quickly as possible.

The SPHA is looking forward to an active and productive new year. Ron Baldwin was elected as a new board member this past November and he is already helping to get the board proactively working on the 2020 budget priorities. The highlights for this next year will include repairing root damage to selected roads, installation of speed bumps on selected roads, and completing the landscaping around the clubhouse.
